

PART 2. NOTICES

A. Claims Made Insurance:

This insurance cover is on a claims made basis. Cover applies only to those **Claims** that are first made during the **Period of Insurance** and any Extended Reporting Period as those terms are described in the insurance contract. Cover does not apply to any **Wrongful Acts** committed before the **Retroactive Date** stated on the Information Page.

B. Claim Expenses Within the Limit:

This insurance cover contains a provision that reduces the Limit of Insurance stated in the insurance contract by the amount of **Claim Expenses**.

C. Awareness:

Various provisions in this insurance contract restrict cover. Read the entire insurance contract carefully to determine **Your** rights and duties, and what is and is not covered. **We** will not pay sums or perform acts or services unless explicitly provided for in this insurance contract.

PART 3. QUICK REFERENCE TO INSURANCE CONTRACT PROVISIONS

The following is a quick reference indexing of **Your** insurance contract's provisions, listed in sequential order. The descriptions in the quick reference are not binding. The quick reference should only be used to help **You** locate the actual insurance contract provisions.

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PART 4. INTRODUCTION

The words **We**, **Us** and **Our** refer to the Insurer named on the Information Page.

The words **You** and **Your** refer individually and collectively to:

1. The **Named Insured** as defined in Part 6.1.;
2. The **Named Insured's** shareholders for their liability as shareholders;
3. The **Named Insured's** partners, officers, directors and employees, but only for **Wrongful Acts** within the scope of their duties in such capacity for the **Named Insured**;
4. Former partners, officers, directors and employees of the **Named Insured**, but only for **Wrongful Acts** both:
 - a. Within the scope of their duties for the **Named Insured**; and
 - b. Made while they were the **Named Insured's** partner, officer, director or employee; and
5. In the event of death, incompetence, insolvency, or bankruptcy of any of **You**, **Your** legal representative but only for **Wrongful Acts** within the scope of their duties for the **Named Insured**.

Other words or phrases that are **bold-faced** have special meaning. Refer to Part 6.

PART 5. INSURING AGREEMENTS AND EXCLUSIONS

A. What We Insure

1. Payments

We will pay on **Your** behalf those sums in excess of the **Self-insured Excess** and within the applicable Limit of Insurance stated in Item 5 on the Information Page that **You** become legally obligated to pay as **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** because of **Claims** as a result of a **Wrongful Act** in performing **Cyberspace Activities** for others, including obtaining, processing, uttering or disseminating **Content** in or for the **Cyberspace Activities**.

2. Defence

We will have the right and duty to appoint a lawyer and defend a covered **Claim**, even if the allegations are groundless, false or fraudulent. But:

- a. **We** may, at **Our** discretion, investigate and settle a covered **Claim**; and
- b. **Our** right and duty to defend and pay on **Your** behalf ends when **We** have used up the applicable Limit of Insurance in payment of **Damages** or **Claim Expenses**.

B. What We Do Not Insure – Exclusions

1. **We** are not obligated to pay **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** or defend **Claims** arising directly or indirectly out of actual or alleged:

- a. **Bodily Injury** or **Property Damage**;
- b. harassment, misconduct or discrimination because of or relating to race, creed, colour, age, sex, sexual preference, national origin, religion, handicap, disability or marital status;
- c. infringement of patent;
- d. malfunction or defect of any hardware, equipment or component, except this Exclusion does not apply when the malfunction or defect is solely the result of **Your** negligence in performing **Cyberspace Activities**;
- e. electrical failure including electrical power interruption, surge, brownout or blackout;
- f. unauthorised access to, use of, tampering with or introduction of malicious code into data or systems by any person;
- g. liability assumed under any contract or agreement, except this Exclusion does not apply to liability which **You** would have incurred in the absence of such contract or agreement;

- h. breach of contract, warranty or guarantee;
- i. false, misleading, deceptive, fraudulent or misrepresenting statements in advertising about **Your** own product or service;
- j. antitrust, restraint of trade, or unfair or deceptive trade practices;
- k. acts by **You** related to any pension, healthcare, welfare, profit sharing, mutual or investment plans, funds or trusts; or any violation of any provision of the U.K. Financial Services Act of 1986, the U.S. Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, or any amendments to the Acts or any violation of any regulations, rulings or orders issued pursuant to such Acts;
- l. violation of:
 - (1) the U.K. Financial Services Act of 1986 as amended;
 - (2) the U.S. Securities Act of 1933 as amended;
 - (3) the U.S. Securities Exchange Act of 1934 as amended;
 - (4) any blue sky or securities law;
 - (5) any similar international, national, state or local law; or
 - (6) any order, ruling or regulation issued pursuant to the above laws;
- m. employer-employee relations or other usual and ordinary business transactions of **Yours** that do not directly involve the performance of **Your Cyberspace Activities**; or
- n. discharge, dispersal or release or threatened discharge, dispersal or release of any **Pollutant**; or the creation of an injurious condition involving any **Pollutant**; or the existence of any **Pollutant** on any property; or the clean-up, removal, testing, monitoring, containment, treatment, detoxification or neutralisation of any **Pollutant**. This Exclusion is effective whether or not the pollution was sudden, accidental, gradual, intended, expected or preventable or whether or not any of **You** caused or contributed to the pollution.

"Pollutant" means any solid, liquid, gaseous or thermal irritant or contaminant, including, but not limited to:

- (1) smoke, vapour, soot, fumes, acids, alkalis, chemicals, or asbestos;
- (2) hazardous, toxic or radioactive matter or nuclear radiation;
- (3) waste, which includes material to be recycled, reconditioned or reclaimed; or
- (4) any other pollutant as defined by applicable international, national, state or local statutes, regulations, rulings or ordinances.

2. **We** are not obligated to pay **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** or defend **Claims** for or arising directly or indirectly out of:

- a. any act, error or omission intentionally committed while knowing it was wrongful; or
- b. an act, error or omission that a jury, court or arbitrator finds dishonest, fraudulent, criminal or malicious. This Exclusion does not apply to **Claim Expenses** incurred by **Us** prior to such finding. However, upon that determination by a jury, court or arbitrator, **We** will have the right to seek recovery of the **Claim Expenses** incurred from the party(ies) found to have committed dishonest, fraudulent, criminal or malicious acts.

3. **We** are not obligated to pay **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** or defend **Claims** made by:

- a. any of **You**;
- b. any entity which is a parent, affiliate, subsidiary, joint venturer, co-venturer or other entity in which any of **You** owns an interest or is a partner;
- c. any entity directly or indirectly controlled, operated or managed by an entity described in Part 5.B.3.b. above;
- d. any independent contractor supplying **Content**, material or services to **You**, but only with respect to **Claims** involving disputes over the ownership or exercise of rights in the **Content**, material or services supplied; or
- e. any regulatory authority, or any administrative actions, decisions, orders, rulings or proceedings by any international, national, state or local governmental agency.

C. **Where and When We Insure**

1. **Where We Insure**

The territory and jurisdiction of this insurance contract is universal. Cover applies to **Wrongful Acts** committed anywhere and to **Claims** made in any jurisdiction in the world. If **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** are incurred in a currency other than the currency designated in the Information Page, payment under this insurance contract shall be made in the currency designated in the Information Page at the closing mid-market rate of exchange published in the London *Financial Times* for the date on which the payment is made.

2. **When We Insure**

- a. **Claims First Made**

This insurance applies when a written **Claim** is first made against any of **You** during the **Period of Insurance**. To be covered, the **Claim** must also arise from a **Wrongful Act** committed during the **Period of Insurance**.

We will consider a **Claim** to be first made against **You** when a written **Claim** is first received by any of **You**.

This insurance also applies to **Claims** under the following conditions:

b. **Prior Wrongful Acts**

We will cover a written **Claim** first made against any of **You** arising from a **Wrongful Act** committed between the **Retroactive Date** and the Inception Date of this insurance contract, but only if all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The written **Claim** is first made against any of **You** during the **Period of Insurance**. **We** will consider a **Claim** to be first made against **You** when a written **Claim** is first received by any of **You**;
- (2) None of **You** knew prior to the Inception Date of a circumstance that could reasonably be expected to lead to the **Claim**; and
- (3) There is no other valid and collectible insurance for the **Claim**.

c. **Reported Wrongful Acts**

We will cover a written **Claim** first made against any of **You** after the end of the **Period of Insurance**, but only if all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The **Wrongful Act** is committed between the **Retroactive Date** and the end of the **Period of Insurance**;
- (2) **We** receive written notice from **You** during the **Period of Insurance** of the **Wrongful Act**. The notice must include all of the following information:
 - (a) The names of those persons or organisations involved in the **Wrongful Act**;
 - (b) The specific person or organisation likely to make the **Claim**;
 - (c) A description of the time, place and nature of the **Wrongful Act**; and
 - (d) A description of the potential **Damages**;
- (3) None of **You** knew prior to the Inception Date of a circumstance that could reasonably be expected to lead to the **Claim**; and
- (4) There is no other valid and collectible insurance for the **Claim**.

A **Claim** first made after the end of the **Period of Insurance** and arising from a reported **Wrongful Act** will be covered under the provisions of the insurance contract in effect on the date **We** receive the notice of the **Wrongful Act**.

d. Extended Reporting Period

This section describes the provisions and conditions that apply to **Claims** first made after the end of the **Period of Insurance** when **You** have not reported a **Wrongful Act** during the **Period of Insurance** in accordance with Part 5.C.2.c. above. Such **Claims** are not automatically covered. To cover them, the First **Named Insured** must purchase an Extended Reporting Period from **Us**.

If the First **Named Insured** purchases an Extended Reporting Period, **We** will cover a **Claim** first made against any of **You** during the Extended Reporting Period, but only if all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The **Wrongful Act** is committed between the **Retroactive Date** and the end of the **Period of Insurance**;
- (2) None of **You** knew prior to the Inception Date of a circumstance that could reasonably be expected to lead to the **Claim**; and
- (3) There is no other valid and collectible insurance for the **Claim**.

We will consider a **Claim** to be made during the Extended Reporting Period only if written **Claim** is first received by any of **You** after the Expiration Date of the **Period of Insurance** and prior to the Expiration Date stated in the Extended Reporting Period Endorsement.

The following provisions and conditions also apply to the Extended Reporting Period:

- (4) If **We** cancel or non-renew the insurance contract, and upon request by the First **Named Insured**, **We** will sell an Extended Reporting Period, unless **We** cancel or non-renew the insurance contract because:
 - (a) Any of **You** failed to pay the premium or **Self-insured Excess**; or
 - (b) Any of **You** failed to comply with insurance contract provisions.

Extended Reporting Period options and the respective percentage of the Premium, as stated in Item 7 of the Information Page, **You** must pay to purchase the Extended Reporting Period are:

One Year = not greater than 200%
Two Years = not greater than 300%

Changes or proposed changes in premium or insurance contract provisions shall not be construed as cancellation or non-renewal of the insurance contract by **Us**.

If **You** cancel or non-renew the insurance contract, **We** may, at **Our** sole option, offer to sell the First **Named Insured** an Extended Reporting Period for an additional premium;

- (5) **We** must receive the First **Named Insured's** request for the Extended Reporting Period in writing within 30 days after the end of the **Period of Insurance**. On receipt and acceptance of the request, **We** will issue an endorsement showing the Extended Reporting Period in accordance with the option requested by the First **Named Insured**. At the same time, **We** will bill the additional premium, and **We** must receive payment within 30 days after the billing date for the endorsement to be effective;
- (6) The endorsement shall also include the provisions and conditions applicable to the Extended Reporting Period. Once in effect, the Extended Reporting Period may not be cancelled;
- (7) A **Claim** that is first made during the Extended Reporting Period will be deemed to have been made on the last day of the **Period of Insurance**. The provisions of the insurance contract in effect on the last day of the **Period of Insurance** will apply;
- (8) The Extended Reporting Period does not reinstate or increase the Limit of Insurance; and
- (9) The Extended Reporting Period does not extend the **Period of Insurance** or change the scope of cover provided.

e. **Multiple Claims**

All **Claims** arising from the same **Wrongful Act** will be deemed to have been made on the earlier of the following times:

- (1) The date the first of those **Claims** is made against any of **You**; or
- (2) The first date **We** receive **Your** written notice of the **Wrongful Act**.

The provisions of the insurance contract in effect on that date will apply.

D. Limit of Insurance, Self-insured Excess and Reimbursement

1. Limit of Insurance

a. Each Wrongful Act

The Each **Wrongful Act** Limit of Insurance stated in Item 5.a. on the Information Page is the most **We** will pay for **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** combined for the total of all **Claims** made during the **Period of Insurance** and any Extended Reporting Period arising from one **Wrongful Act**, no matter how many:

- (1) Of **You** this insurance contract covers;
- (2) **Claims** are made; or
- (3) Persons or organisations make **Claims**.

b. Total Limit of Insurance

The Total Limit of Insurance stated in Item 5.b. on the Information Page is the most **We** will pay for **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** combined for the total of all **Claims** made during the **Period of Insurance** and any Extended Reporting Period, no matter how many:

- (1) Of **You** this insurance contract covers;
- (2) **Claims** are made;
- (3) Persons or organisations make **Claims**; or
- (4) **Wrongful Acts** are committed.

2. Self-insured Excess

A separate **Self-insured Excess** applies to each actual and/or alleged **Wrongful Act**. For purposes of this provision, a series of related **Wrongful Acts**, as described in Part 6.M., will be considered a single **Wrongful Act**. The **Self-insured Excess** applies to **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** combined, and **Our** obligation to pay **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** applies only to the amount of **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** in excess of the **Self-insured Excess**. The Limit of Insurance will not be reduced by the application of the **Self-insured Excess**. The amount of **Your Self-insured Excess** is stated in Item 6 on the Information Page.

3. Reimbursement

If, at **Our** option, **We** have paid any amounts for **Damages** or **Claim Expenses** in excess of the applicable Limit of Insurance or if **We** have paid part or all of any **Self-insured Excess**, the **Named Insured** shall be liable to reimburse such amounts to **Us** upon demand.

PART 6. DEFINITIONS USED IN THIS INSURANCE CONTRACT

- A. "Application or Renewal Application"** means all the following:
1. The **Named Insured's** signed Application for CyberLiability Plus™ Insurance;
 2. The **Named Insured's** signed Renewal Application for CyberLiability Plus™ Insurance, if this is a renewal of an insurance contract issued by **Us**; and
 3. All attachments to the **Application or Renewal Application** and any other information furnished to **Us** for the purpose of applying for the insurance. All such attachments and information will be kept on file by **Us** and deemed attached to the insurance contract as if physically attached to it.
- B. "Bodily Injury"** means physical injury, sickness or disease sustained by a person, including death resulting from any of these at any time. **Bodily Injury** also means disability, emotional distress, mental anguish, mental injury, shock or fright when these conditions are the result of physical injury, sickness, disease or death.
- C. "Claim"** means a demand or assertion of a legal right seeking **Damages** made against any of **You**.
- D. "Claim Expenses"** means expenses incurred by **Us** or by **You** with **Our** consent in the investigation, adjustment, negotiation, arbitration, mediation and defence of covered **Claims**, whether paid by **Us** or **You** with **Our** consent. **Claim Expenses** include:
1. Expenses **We** incur;
 2. Lawyers fees;
 3. Costs taxed against **You** in any suit defended by **Us**;
 4. Interest on the full amount of any judgement that accrues after entry of the judgement and before **We** have paid, offered to pay or deposited in court the part of the judgement that is within the applicable Limit of Insurance;
 5. The cost of appeal bonds or bonds to release attachments, but only for bond amounts within the applicable Limits of Insurance. **We** do not have to furnish these bonds; and
 6. Reasonable expenses incurred by **You** at **Our** request other than:
 - a. Loss of earnings; and
 - b. Salaries or other compensation paid to any of **You**.

- E. **"Content"** means printed, audio, visual, digital or informational material.
- F. **"Cyberspace Activities"** means those services or other activities as described in Item 4. of the Information Page.
- G. **"Damages"** means monetary judgement, award or settlement, including those that are actual, statutory, punitive or exemplary, except when applicable law prohibits insurance for punitive or exemplary damages; and legal expense or other costs included as part of a judgement, award or settlement.

Damages does not include civil or criminal fines or penalties; royalties, fines or penalties sought by any music licensing organisation; disputed: royalties, fees, deposits, commissions or charges for goods or services; or loss or disgorgement of profits by any of **You**. **Damages** also does not include costs of correcting or performing or reperforming **Your Cyberspace Activities** by **You** or another party when **You** have the capability to correct, perform or reperform the activity that generated the costs.

- H. **"Self-insured Excess"** means the amount stated in Item 6 on the Information Page and described in Part 5.D. 2. of this insurance contract.

- I. **"Named Insured"** means:

1. The person or entity listed in Item 1 of the Information Page; and
2. Any entity which is created or acquired during the **Period of Insurance** and which is wholly-owned by another **Named Insured**. This provision applies only:
 - a. To **Cyberspace Activities** performed on or after the date of creation or acquisition of the new **Named Insured**;
 - b. If **You** advise **Us** within 60 days of the creation or acquisition and provide reasonable information for **Us** to evaluate for material changes in conditions which may affect insurance afforded by the insurance contract; and
 - c. If **You** agree to pay any additional premium **We** believe is reasonable and necessary as a result of the material changes, if any.

The First **Named Insured** is the **Named Insured** first listed on the Information Page.

- J. **"Period of Insurance"** means the period of time stated in Item 2 on the Information Page, or any shorter period resulting from cancellation of the insurance contract.

K. "Property Damage" means physical injury to tangible property and any resulting loss or corruption of data or information, including all resulting loss of use of that property, data or information.

Property Damage does not mean the loss, corruption or destruction of data or information when the tangible property on which the data or information resides or resided is not physically injured.

L. "Retroactive Date" means the date, if any, stated in Item 3 on the Information Page.

M. "Wrongful Act" means the following conduct or alleged conduct by **You** or any person or organisation for whom **You** are legally liable:

1. any form of defamation or other tort related to disparagement or harm to the character, reputation or feelings of any person or organisation, including libel, slander, product disparagement, trade libel, infliction of emotional distress, malicious falsehood, outrage or outrageous conduct;
2. any form of invasion, infringement or interference with rights of privacy or publicity, including false light, public disclosure of private facts, intrusion, breach of confidence and commercial appropriation of name or likeness;
3. infringement of title, slogan, trademark, trade name, trade dress, service mark or service name;
4. infringement of copyright, false attribution of authorship, passing off, plagiarism or misappropriation of ideas under implied contract;
5. misuse of an intellectual property right in **Content**, but only when alleged in conjunction with the types of **Claims** named in 3. and 4. above;
6. wrongful entry or eviction, trespass, eavesdropping or other invasion of the right of private occupancy;
7. false arrest, detention or imprisonment or malicious prosecution;
8. errors, omissions or negligent acts.

All **Wrongful Acts** that:

1. Take place between the **Retroactive Date** and the end of the **Period of Insurance** of the last CyberLiability Plus™ Insurance contract issued to **You**, and
2. Are related by common facts, circumstances, transactions, events and/or decisions

will be treated under this insurance contract as one **Wrongful Act**.

PART 7. GENERAL CONDITIONS – These conditions apply to the entire insurance contract.

A. Special Rights and Duties of the First Named Insured

The First **Named Insured** is responsible for the payment of all premiums and **Self-insured Excess(es)**. The First **Named Insured** has exclusive authority to act on behalf of all of **You** with respect to matters relating to this insurance contract, including:

1. Giving and receiving notice of cancellation and non-renewal;
2. Receiving refunds;
3. Agreeing to any changes to this insurance contract; and
4. Purchasing an Extended Reporting Period.

B. What to Do if You Have a Claim or Suit

1. If there is a **Claim** or a circumstance likely to result in a **Claim**, **You** must do the following:
 - a. Notify **Us** in writing as soon as practicable; this notice must:
 - (1) Be sent to **Us**, in care of **Our** underwriting manager acting on **Our** behalf, Media/Professional Insurance Two Pershing Square, 2300 Main Suite 800, Kansas City, Missouri 64108-2404; and
 - (2) Contain details that identify **You**, the claimant and also reasonably obtainable information concerning the time, place and other details of the **Wrongful Act** and **Claim**;
 - b. Immediately send **Us** copies of all demands, notices, writs, summonses or legal papers received in connection with the **Claim**;
 - c. Authorise **Us** to obtain records and other information;
 - d. Co-operate with and assist **Us** in the investigation, settlement or defence of the **Claim**; and
 - e. Assist **Us**, upon **Our** request, in enforcing any rights of contribution or indemnity against another who may be liable to any of **You**.
2. None of **You** will, except at **Your** own cost, voluntarily make a payment, admit liability, assume any obligation or incur any expense without **Our** prior written consent.

C. Legal Action Against Us

No person or organisation has a right under this insurance:

1. To join **Us** as a party or otherwise bring **Us** into a suit or other legal action asking for **Damages** from any of **You**; or
2. To sue **Us** on this insurance unless all of the insurance contract's provisions have been fully complied with.

A person or organisation may sue **Us** to recover on "an agreed settlement" or on a final judgement against **You** obtained after an actual trial; but **We** will not be liable for **Damages** and **Claim Expenses** that are not payable under the provisions of this insurance or that are in excess of the applicable Limit of Insurance. "An agreed settlement" means a settlement and release of liability signed by **Us**, **You** and the claimant or the claimant's legal representative.

D. Bankruptcy

The bankruptcy or insolvency of **You** or **Your** estate will not relieve **Us** of **Our** obligation under this insurance. However, this insurance will not apply to liability directly or indirectly due to such bankruptcy, insolvency, receivership or subsequent liquidation.

E. Other Insurance

If other valid and collectible insurance is available to any of **You** for any **Claim We** cover, this insurance is excess over such other insurance, except when the other insurance is purchased by the **Named Insured** only to apply in excess of this insurance and no other insurance exists.

F. Transfer of Rights of Recovery Against Others to Us

You and **We** may have rights to recover all or part of any payment **You** or **We** make under this insurance. If so, those rights are transferred to **Us**.

You must do nothing to impair such rights. At **Our** request, **You** will bring suit or transfer those rights to **Us** and help **Us** enforce them. Any recoveries shall be applied as follows:

1. First, to **Us** up to the amount of **Our** payment for **Damages** and **Claim Expenses**;
2. Then, to the First **Named Insured** as recovery of **Self-insured Excess** amounts paid as **Damages** and **Claim Expenses**.

G. Changes in Insurance Contract Provisions; Changes in Your Operations

1. This insurance contract contains all the agreements between the **Named Insured** and **Us** concerning the insurance afforded by this insurance contract. This insurance contract's provisions can be amended or waived only by written endorsement issued by **Us** and made a part of this insurance contract.
2. This insurance contract applies only to the **Cyberspace Activities** described on the Information Page and **Named Insured(s)** as defined in the insurance contract as of the Inception Date of the **Period of Insurance** or by endorsement. This insurance contract shall not apply to any other services or enterprises unless such services or enterprises are added by written endorsement issued by **Us** and made a part of this insurance contract. If an endorsement is added, **You** shall promptly pay any additional premium which may become due.

H. Transfer of Your Rights and Duties Under the Insurance Contract

Your rights and duties under this insurance contract may not be transferred without **Our** written consent.

I. Cancellation

1. The First **Named Insured** may cancel this insurance contract by mailing or delivering to **Us** or **Our** authorised representative advance written notice of cancellation.
2. **We** may cancel this insurance contract by mailing or delivering to the First **Named Insured** written notice of cancellation at least:
 - a. 10 days before the effective date of cancellation if **We** cancel for non-payment of premium; or
 - b. 30 days before the effective date of cancellation if **We** cancel for any other reason.

We will mail or deliver **Our** notice to the address stated in Item 1 on the Information Page.

Notice of cancellation will state the effective date of cancellation. The **Period of Insurance** will end on that date.

If this insurance contract is cancelled, **We** will send the First **Named Insured** any premium refund due. If **We** cancel, the refund will be pro rata. If the First **Named Insured** cancels, the refund, if any, will be 90% of pro rata. The cancellation will be effective even if **We** have not made or offered a refund.

If notice is mailed, proof of mailing will be sufficient proof of notice.

J. Representations

By accepting this insurance contract, **You** agree:

1. The statements in the **Application or Renewal Application** for this insurance furnished to **Us** are accurate and complete;
2. Those statements furnished to **Us** are representations the **Named Insured** made to **Us** on behalf of all of **You**;
3. Those representations are a material inducement to **Us** to issue this insurance contract;
